Bus Shelter by the Plough – current condition as reported by Cllr JB - Have had a look at the bus shelter by the Plough. and although some of the wood edges to the roof could do with replacement and cutting down some off the hedge behind it. The bus shelter is basically solid and firm and still fit to stand in when raining,

## Disabled toilet at the VH – Cllr JB report

having been in contact with Ideal Standard who own Armitage Shanks, it appears that our toilet is a pre 2008 model, that has a floor to top of seat Hight of 450mm. the pan is 410mm and the seat is 40mm. this was the approved specification for disabled toilets pre 2008, after that the approved specification went up to 480mm in total hight including the seat. At this time Armitage Shanks/Ideal Standard stopped making the earlier pan and seat, and produced one to the later specification with a pan hight of 440mm and a seat of 40mm. The later seat has very slightly different overall measurements to our seat and Ideal Standard don't know if it will fit. but if it fits it would still only make the seat up to the earlier specification of 450mm from the floor, according to Ideal Standard we would need to change the pan and seat, and because the original pan had an outlet pipe with a center off 225mm from the floor compared to the normal measurement off 190mm, they reckon that were we not to fit another Armitage Shanks disabled pan, we would have to change all the waist outlet plumbing, which cos I cant see it without dismantling everything I don't know if it would be a straight forward job or end up costing us more money, they gave me the part numbers of their current pan, seat and flow restrictor(which if we fit there pan we would also need as the new pan is rimless and the clean water flowing into the pan from the existing cistern would be too much and it may come over the edge). I have been and got 2 quotes from plumbing suppliers for the pan, seat and restrictor, "See Attachments." I have an account with Plumbase which is why its nearly £100 cheaper. I can do all of this job which ever way we choose to go, but we could just order the seat first and I could see if it will fit as the differences don't seem to far off, and if it doesn't fit we would then just have to order the pan and restrictor and fit those as well. the only thing is, if we

just replace the seat, would it matter that our disabled toilet was of an earlier hight rather than the later regulations. hope all that makes sense – Link to copy quotes Disabled Toilet repair 2024

- Met with NB and Peter Beeden of Bourne Sports plus sports clubs re drainage works on the 9v9 pitch. Sports clubs agreed for work to commence in September.
